The Chapter occasionally schedules an extended trip every other year of 7 or more days. Extended trips are voted on by the Chapter. The Chapter might also elect to have a mystery trip once a year.

All Members are usually asked to plan one campout or luncheon each year. Usually the owners of two rigs are paired to plan an event. Some of our members are single owners of a rig.

Chapter members range in ages, but most are retired as we camp Monday to Friday.

The chapter does campouts usually with full hookups. However, we also attend both State campouts, the Rally in June and the Tag Along in September, both of which have no hookups (“dry camping”)
